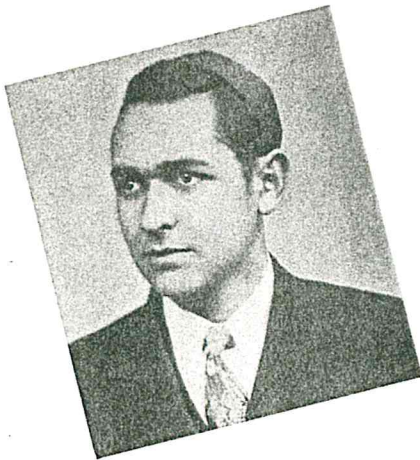

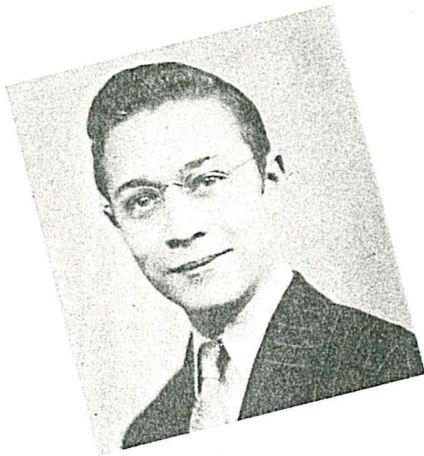
BALSAM, MILTON

And all his words are true.



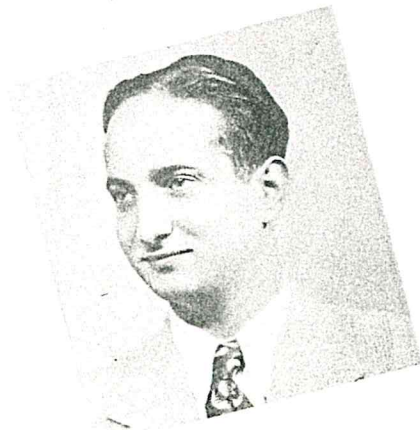
BERGER, EMANUEL

In him we have reliance.



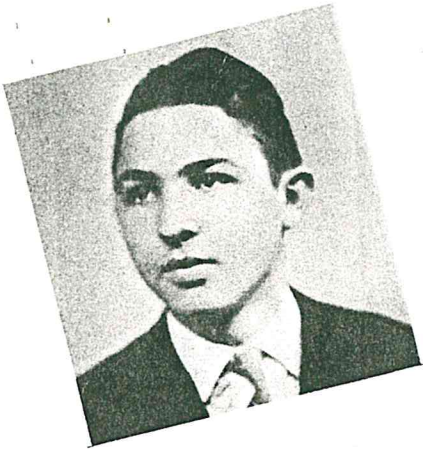
BOTNICK, SAMUEL

O'er running with a smile.



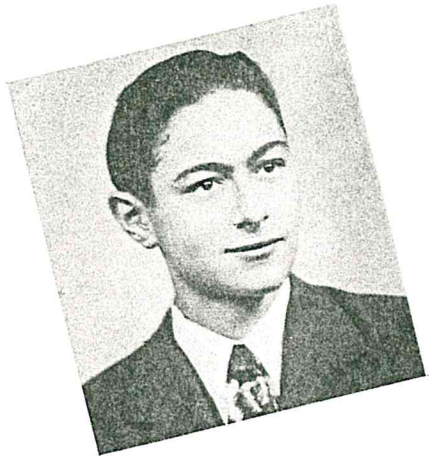

Now success has come his way.



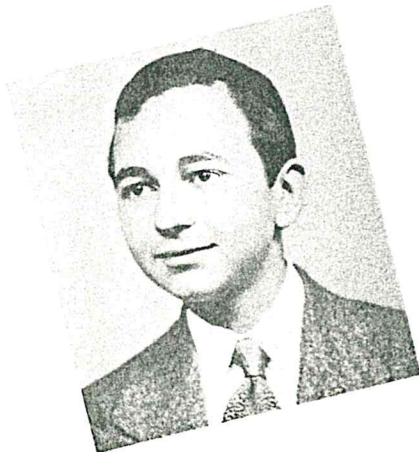

PARNASS, MILTON

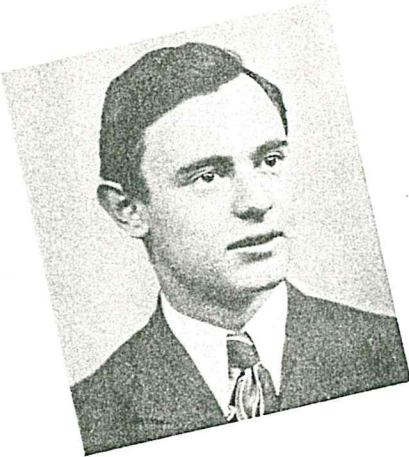

To reach its far-off goal.



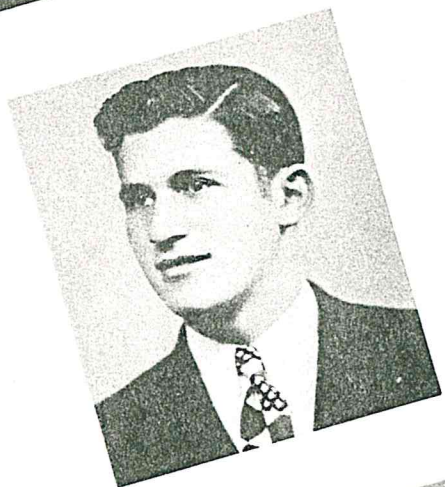
