

It was 2:00 P.M., Yom Kippur afternoon, when the combined forces of Egypt and Syria charged across the borders of Israel, shattering the solemnity of Judaism's holiest day. Fatigued from fasting, their prayer shawls wrapped tightly around their necks, the people of Israel rushed from the sunagogues, and plunged into war. The embattled yishuv was wholly unprepared for this perfidious attack, and it was only through the good grace of G-d, that the heroic defenders of the Jewish state repulsed and vanquished the Arab invaders. Once again, however, as in wars past, Klal Yisroel paid a dear and costly price. Once again, the hills of Sinai were strewn with Jewish corpses, its deserts soaked with Jewish blood. The battlefields reeked with the odor of twisted weapons of war, and the charred and mutilated bodies of Jewish youth. From the ranges of the Golan, to the banks of the Suez, the valiant soldiers of Klal Yisroel fell, in defense of their people, and in sanctification of G-d. It is in honor of these brave men, who gave their lives for the people and land they held so dear, that we dedicate The Scroll.




### YOSSI ASZKNAZY

Communications, speech, language — if man can properly harness the powerful idea that these words express, then man will be an important step closer to one of his ultimate goals, world peace.

However, public condemnation and conviction of wrongdoing not proven are blatant violations of the rights of the defendents, rights that are extended them by the same constitution that we feel has been attacked.

It is this area that the true "Watergate Crisis" lies. Regardless of the outcome, the decision concerning the present situation will not go down in history simply as a judgment on possible wrongdoing on the part of the President. It will carry multiple overtones in regard to the ability of our system to provide adequate protection of the rights of those who have not been convicted in a courtroom, but have been convicted in the public's eye. If these rights are allowed to erode, our entire system of democratic government will be in grave danger.

The Founding Fathers had a monumental task in their attempt to produce a single document which would be able to weather the storms of time and remain functional. It remains to be seen whether our constitution can withstand the latest crisis, the withering away of the basic right of "innocent until proven guilty."

### הממשלה כיהודה כומן הכית הראשון

רצוני לחקור בנושא זה, ולברר במילות קצרות ובסברות ישרה (עם נימוקים מכמה מקומות מהתלמודים) את אופן ממשלת היהודית על פי תורתנו הקדושה.

ידוע לכל, שחייבה אותנו התורה בסיני מלך "שום תשים "עליך מלך" (דברים י"ז, ט"ו), ובהקמת סנהדרין גדולה שנאמר "שופטים ושוטרים תתן לך בכל שעריך" (דברים ט"ז, י"ח). שניהם מהווים את ממשלת ישראל ויען שחלוקים המה בתפקידיהם, ברוחותם, ובדיניהם אצמצם רק בדיני המלך.

- א) מצותה: "שום תשים עליך מלך" (דברים י"ז, ט"ז) התורה מצווית אותנו במינוי מלך שחייבים בכבודו. שיטת הרמב"ם בפ"א הלכות מלכים ושיטת הרמב"ן בפרשת שופטים (דברים י"ח, ט"ו) היא שהיתה מצוה על ישראל, בזמן כניסתן לארץ, למנות לעצמם מלך (משבט יהודה (1). לעומת זה קיימת שיטת האברבנאל (שמואל א, פרק ה, עמוד כ"ז, הוצאת ירושלים תשט"ו) שעל פי התורה צריכה ממשלת ישראל להיות על פי השגחת ה', כלומר שנביא ה' יהיה מנהיגם. אך, ידע הקב"ה את טיבם של ישראל, וצוה שאם במקרה "יחטאו" וירצו למנות מלך, ולא להתנהג על פי נביא, אז יש להם חיוב למנות מלך, כלומר: שמצות מינוי מלך נאמרה "כנגד היצר הרע". (ודוגמתו במצוות יפת תאר).
- ב) העמדתו: שיטת הרמב"ם (פ"א מהלכות מלכים ה"ג) דהעמדת מלך "בתחילה" (כלומר: כשבאים ליסד שלשלת מלכים) תהיה על פי בית דין של ע"א יחד עם נביא, אך, להמשכת המלכות, היינו כשמת המלך ורוצים להמליך את בנו, צריכים רק בי"ד ולא נביא (סנהדרין דף ב:). אך, שיטת הרמב"ן בפרשת שופטים (דברים י"ח, ט"ו) שונה היא, שס בר שלפי פשטות המקרא צריכים רק בי"ד ולא נביא בכל המקרים. מעניינת היא שיטת החינוך (מצוה תצ"ו) שלהעביר המלוכה ממלך שנפטר לבנו היא חלק מן המצוה של השמת מלך, אך, במקרא שאין בית דין ונביא, מצד הסברה נראה שהסכמת האומה יועיל להשים על נציגם דיני מלך, ועדיין צריך עיון. (משפט כהן סימן קמ"ד אות ט"ו, שו"ת היכל יצחק אורח חיים סימן ל"ו).
- ג) מלכי ישראל: אחרי משיחית דוד, זכו כל בניו הזכרים (ב) במלכות לעולמי עד. אך, מתעוררת הבעיה על מלכי ישראל. מבואר מהרמב"ם (פ"א שם ה"ח) דלנביא יש רשות להעמוד מלך משבט אחר אך לא תקוים מלכותו. מקור הדברים הוא בירושלמי פ"ג דהוריות ה"ב דמבואר שמה, דיש רשות לנביא על פי "הוראת שעה" להעמיד מלך משבט אחר, ותו שיהיה לאיש הזה דין מלך גמור. (יוצא אפוא דהמלכים הכהגים בזמן בית שני לא היתה להם דין מלך (3) יען דכבר נפסקה הנבואה כדאיתא במסכת סנהדרין דף י"א, וברש"י יומא דף כ"א). אך, שיטת הרמב"ן (בראשית מ"ט, פסוק י") היא דבנביאות יעקב "לא יסור שבט מיהודה" (שם), מוכח דרק לדוד (הוא משבט יהודה) יש רשות המלוכה, והמלכים משאר שבטי ישראל הם רק כשופטים.
- ד) מרידה במלך: כתב הרמב"ם בפירוש המשניות בפרק חלק (יסוד שנים עשר) דאחר משיחת דוד למלך, כל מי שימרוד במלכות בית דוד (היינו שחלק על כל דבר המשיחה, ועל כל "זכות" הירושה והמלכות לבית דוד) נקרא "מין" "ומצווים" בהריגתו. אך, לעומת זה, כשמורדים רק במלך אחד יש לו דין מורד במלכות ורשות ביד המלך להורגו (אבל חיובא ליכא (4). באופני ההריגה קימת מחלוקת הראשונים, דעת התום' במס' סנהדרין דף ל"ו ובמגילה דף י"ד דצריכים לזה חקירת הבית דין הגבוהה, ואם יתחייב אז מותר למלך להורגו (5). אך, סוברים הר"ן בסנהדרין שם והטורי אבן במגילה שם, שאין המלך זקוק להסקמת הבית דין להורגו.

מצינו בירושלמי פ"ב דסנהדרין ופ"א דראש השנה, דכל זמן נפקע ממנו המלכות בסיבת מרידה אז הרי הוא "כיחיד" ואין בו שום דין מלך. כדומה לזה, אם מת המלך ובאים למנות מלך חדש, והעם מתנגד למינוייו, אז צריכים הבית דין למנות את המלך על ידי משיחה, למרות שבן היורש את המלוכה אינו זקוק למשיחה. בסיבת צורך המשיחה קיימת מחלוקת הראשונים. דעת רש"י (מסכת כתובות דף ה:) שזה כמו הקמת מלך חדש (שזקוק למשיחה). לעומת זה, סובר הרמב"ם (פ"א דכלי המקדש הי"א) דסיבת המשיחה היא כדי להשקיט את העם. והספרי (שופטים פרשת ל"ט) מוסיף, שאם העם עדין עומד בהתנגדותו, אז אין לו דין מלך.

ה) כוחותיו: רשות יש למלך לדון לא על פי התורה ואפילו לדון למיתה ואפילו בלי עדים (ירושלמי סנהדריז פ"ו ה"ו) ושופט את העם בצדק. אך, יש כח לסנהדרין לדון את המלך (סנהדרין דף כ"ו). וכשהוא לטובת המדינה יכול המלך להפקיר נכסי יחידים (שם). אך, כשמפקיר בלי שום תועלת מדינית, אז הרי הוא כגזלן (רמב"ם פ"ג מלכים ה"ח). כשרוצה ללחום מלחמת רשות (היינו רק לכבוש שטחים) צריך ליטול רשות הבית דין (סנהדרין דף ב:). אך, כשלוחם מלחמת מצוה (והיינו ז' אומות או הצלת ישראל מעכו"ם) כופה את כולם ללכת למלחמה, ואז יוצאים אפילו חתן מחדרו וכלה מחופתה ואין לשום איש ליפטר ממנו (סנהדרין דף מד:). וכמו כן, יש לו רשות לתבוע מאנשי מלכותו להיות לו לעבדים (לבנות בתים ולסלול מסילות וכו"). אך, עם כל זה צריך המלך להתנהג במדה שווה לאנשי מלכותו, ובקרבו יהיה עניו, ויכבד לומדי התורה ויחזקם בכוחות הנתונים לו, וישמור המצוות. ואם ישמרם יתקיים מלכותו לעולמי עד ולא ינזק לעולם, שנאמר "ואם ישמרו בניך את דרכם ללכת לפני יתקיים מלכותו לעולמי עד ולא ינזק לעולם, שנאמר "ואם ישמרו בניך את דרכם ללכת ב, ד).

שנזכה לביאת הגואל ולחידוש מלכות בית דוד, במהרה בימנו אמן סלה.

"מה אדם ותדעיהו"? כלומר ד "מה אתה רוצה לברוא את האד"ם בשעה שאתה יודע בו שעתיד לחטוא לפניך...? אמרה להם שכינה: למה זה תקטרגו על האדם? הלא אף בחטאו גדול הוא מכם...! "ולא עוד אלא כשהאדם חוטא - כבר הקדמתי לו התשובה, שישוב אל בוראו ויתקן חמאין...! אמרו לו: אם כן מאי כולו האי...? "הלא מוטב היה אולי לא ברא אותו כלל, ולא יגיע לו לאדם לא עונש ולא שכר, משיברא ויחטא, ויקלקל, ויגרם לכם מה שגרם...! אמר להם ר' שמעון: בדין היא שיברא אותו כך, שהרי בשבילי נבראה התורה אשר כתוב בה עונש לרשעים ושכר טוב לצדיקים... ולא יתכן שכר לצדיקים ועונש לרשעים, אלא... בשבילי האדם שנברא... אשר הטוב - והרע, החיים - ההמות לפניו... הנה עולם כה נורא, וכה מפליא, ובעל תוקה ועצמה כה רבה, עולם רחב ידים, ומלא חכמה, ובסדר כה נפלא ושלם, הרי שלמות כה מפליאה ומפתיעה יופי והדר כה מפואר וכה רב. עד שאפילו מול הפחות והפעוט שבנבראים כורעים ומשתחוים מבני האדם ומודים ואומרים: אין צור כאלוקינו - ואין צייר כאלוקינו ולא יפלא האדם בעולמו זה, ולא יהרהר וישאל ברתת של תמהון: ? העולמים! מה אליה ועל כל מה אלה ומה אני, ולשם מה אני? ומה חובתי בעולמך... ובעולמו...? וכראי שהאדם יענה על כך בעצמו צריך הוא לפשפש במעשיו ולמצא בהם עליונות משאר הברואים ... אמר משה רבינו לפני הקדוש־ברוך־הוא, רבונו של עולם במה תרום קרן של ישראל? אמו' לו, "כי תשא את ראש בני ישראל לפקודיהם...", במה היא נשיאות - ראש שלהן? בצדקה - "ונתנו איש כפר נפשו לה' וגו' . . . ומפרשים זאת, כפר נפש - איש עשרו. וע"כ צריך אדם לנהוג את עצמו שנאמר "באורח צדקה חיים ודרך נתיבה אל־מות, שכל הרגיל העושה צדקה עם חבירו מעלין עליו כאלו החיה אותו. וצריך נתיבה אל - מות. שכל הרגיל בצדקה מעל מלאך המות שאינו יכול לשלוט בו, וזאת היא דרכם של צדיקים, ועוד אמרו

הכמים "ברוח הצדקה המתים עתידים לחיות". ראיה - שמצאנו אצל אליהו התשבי שהוא הולך מהר אל הר וממערה אל מערה והלך לו לצרפית, לאשה אלמנה וקבלתו בכבוד גדול, מינה, ומפתה, ומשמנה היו אוכלין ושותין חוא והיא ובנה, ולאחרי ימים, חלה בן האשה ומת, והחיה אותו אליהו בתפילתו.

וכן השונמית כבדה את אלישע - שנאמר - יעשה נא עליה - קיר קטנה ונשים לו שם מטה ושלחן וכסא ומנורה וכל פעם שהיה עובר אלישע דרך שם, יסור שמה, ובשרה שתלד בן והרה וילדה, ומת, והחיה אותו.

וכאשר יגיע אדם לחובתו בעולמו - אז ישמח ה' במעשיו: לשון עתיד - כלומר מרם שמח בהם, "כך עתיד הוא לשמח במעשיו"!

### מנוחת הנפש האמיתית
